

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 49013.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM CREATING THE HOSPITAL OPERATIONS FUND AND DEFINING ITS FUNCTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 49013.1 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

> "Section 49013.1. Hospital Operations Fund. (a) For the purpose of maintaining separate accounts and financial records of the Guam Memorial Hospital, there is hereby established a fund to be known as the 'Hospital Operations Fund', which shall be maintained separate and apart from any other funds of the government of Guam, and independent records and accounts thereof shall be maintained in connection therewith; provided, however, that the accounts and financial operations of the Fund shall be in accord with the accounting principles and procedures as prescribed by the American Hospital Association for hospitals.

(b) All appropriations for the Guam Memorial Hospital shall be transferred, on a quarterly basis upon certification by the Board of the need therefor, to the Hospital Operations Fund. All debts, liabilities and obligations, and operation expenses of the Guam Memorial Hospital, including the payment of any claims arising from its operation, shall be paid by the Board from said Fund. Employment, award of contracts, procurement of supplies and services, and payment of claims shall be made in accord with pertinent laws and regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

(c) The Board shall render monthly to the Governor and to the Legislature a statement reflecting the financial condition of the Hospital Operations Fund and a financial statement of operations of the Guam Memorial Hospital for the period covered. The Director of Administration shall periodically cause an internal audit of the accounts and records of the Hospital Operations Fund to be made and shall render a report thereon to the Governor and the Legislature. Such internal audit ishall in no wise limit the right of the Legislature to cause an outside audit of such Fund to be made at any time.

(d) There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
to the Hospital Operations Fund such sums as are necessary
to maintain the solvency of said Fund."

and shall expire automatically on June 30, 1973, following which all funds in the Hospital Operations Fund created hereby shall revert to the General Fund.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
