AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY
CAPITAL IMPROVMMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated
3 from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of
4 the General Fund for various capital improvements and for
5 other purposes:

6 I. For General Government

7 A. Replacement of Automotive Equipment

8 for Department of Public Safety \$ 75,000

9 B. Construction of Multi-Purpose

10 Municipal Building (Santa Rita) 50,000

11 C. Construction of Multi-Purpose

1 sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) to the Guam
2 Memorial Hospital to carry out the provisions of Section 2 of
3 Public Law 10-135, Tenth Guam Legislature.

4 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available
5 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
6 sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) to the
7 Low Cost Housing Revolving Fund of the Guam Housing Corporation.

8 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available
9 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
10 the sum of Fifty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety
11 Dollars (\$55,790) for research, eradication and control of the
12 spiny starfish (*Acanthaster planci*).

13 Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from any available
14 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
15 the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) to carry out
16 the provisions of Section 5010 of the Government Code of Guam
17 to provide for the orderly transition between administrations.

18 Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from any available
19 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
20 sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) as and for the
21 first annual increment of appropriation under the School Fencing
22 Program established by Public Law 10-136, Tenth Guam Legislature.

23 Section 11. There is hereby appropriated from any available
24 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
25 sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) to the
26 Improvement District Revolving Fund created by Section 48026
27 of the Government Code of Guam (Public Law 9-223, Ninth Guam
28 Legislature).

29 Section 12. There is hereby appropriated from any
30 available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
31 Fund the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) to provide a

1 commemorative marker at Pedro C. Santos Memorial Park to
2 suitably commemorate Senator Santos and to make sure that the
3 public knows the name of the park.

4 Section 13. There is hereby appropriated from any available
5 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
6 the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for preparing plans
7 to construct facilities in the Merizo lagoon in the municipality
8 of Merizo for handling passenger liners.

9 Section 14. There is hereby appropriated from any available
10 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
11 the sum of One Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
12 (\$102,500) for the Guam Combat Patrol Veterans Bonuses to
13 carry out the provisions of Public Law 10-101, Tenth Guam
14 Legislature.

15 Section 15. There is hereby appropriated from any available
16 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
17 the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) to the
18 Land Acquisition Fund to acquire properties needed for the
19 air terminal expansion.

20 Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any available
21 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
22 the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) to the Land
23 Acquisition Fund to pay for unpaid judgments in land condemna-
24 tion cases for public school sites.

25 Section 17. All appropriations made by Sections 1, 2,
26 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 of this Act
27 shall be effective immediately and shall be available for all
28 expenses incident to the purpose for which made. Every appro-
29 priation made herein shall continue in full force and effect
30 until expended for the purpose for which made or until the
31 project is completed.

1 Section 18. There is hereby reserved within the Unappro-
2 priated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Three Million
3 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000), to cover the
4 anticipated amount needed to fund the implementation of Public
5 Law 10-125, Tenth Guam Legislature, Public Law 10-126 as
6 amended, Tenth Guam Legislature and the special Civil Service
7 Commission Classification and Compensation Study (The Kamalu
8 Report). The amount so reserved may thereafter be appropriated
9 by the Legislature to the various departments and agencies of
10 the Executive Branch of the government of Guam upon the
11 Legislature's finding as to the actual needs of each department
12 or agency for said implementation.
