Section 18. There is hereby reserved within the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Three Million. Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000), to cover the anticipated amount needed to fund the implementation of Public Law 10-125, Tenth Guam Legislature, Public Law 10-126 as amended, Tenth Guam Legislature and the special Civil Service Commission Classification and Compensation Study (The Kamalu Report). The amount so reserved may thereafter be appropriated by the Legislature to the various departments and agencies of the Executive Branch of the government of Guam upon the Legislature's finding as to the actual needs of each department or agency for said implementation.
