AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH (j) TO
SECTION 17501 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF
GUAM TO PERMIT THE TERRITORIAL PLANNING
COMMISSION TO GRANT VARIANCES AUTHORIZING
CERTAIN LOT PARCELING IN RURAL ZONES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (j) is hereby added to Section
3 17501 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "(j) Permit the owner of a lot in a rural zone
5 to parcel therefrom one lot not less than 10,000 square
6 feet in area to be used for a single family residence,
7 such variance to be conditioned upon a prohibition on
8 any subsequent parceling of the lot and that the parcelled
9 out lot be served by water and power and a public road."

10 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
