AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH (j) TO SECTION 17501 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PERMIT THE TERRITORIAL PLANNING COMMISSION TO GRANT VARIANCES AUTHORIZING CERTAIN LOT PARCELING IN RURAL ZONES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subparagraph (j) is hereby added to Section

17501 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"(j) Permit the owner of a lot in a rural zone to parcel therefrom one lot not less than 10,000 square feet in area to be used for a single family residence, such variance to be conditioned upon a prohibition on any subsequent parceling of the lot and that the parcelled out lot be served by water and power and a public road."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
