






AN ACT TO AMEND SUB-PARAGRAPH (a)
OF SECTION 4217 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO REDUCE THE REQUIRED
YEARS OF TOTAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE
PERMITTING PAYMENTS OF RETIREMENT
ANNUITIES TO SURVIVING SPOUSES AND
MINOR CHILDREN FROM FIVE YEARS TO
THREE YEARS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Sub-paragraph (a) of Section 4217 of the
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(a) Upon death of a member, while in service,
5 having completed at least three years to total
6 service, if a surviving spouse or minor children survive
7 the member, the following annuities shall be payable."

8 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
