AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 13213.3 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO RENAME TUMON LOOP ROAD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO AFTER GUAM'S FIRST CATHOLIC MARTYR, FATHER SANVITORES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 13212.3 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

> "Section 13213.3. Pale Sanvitores Road. That public highway in the municipality of Dededo leading from the Hospital Road to the place of Gogna is hereby renamed the 'Pale Sanvitores Road' after Guam's first Catholic martyr, the Jesuit Father Sanvitores."

Section 2. This Act shall take effect on April 2, 1971, the 299th anniversary of Father Sanvitores' martyrdom, at which time the Governor of Guam is hereby directed to dedicate the new road at such ceremony as he deems appropriate.
