AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 680.11 AND SUBSECTION 2 OF SUBPARAGRAPH (b) OF SECTION 1038 OF THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE TO ESTABLISH A PETIT JURY FEE OF \$10.00.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 680.11 of the Code of Civil Procedure is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 680.11. Fees. (a) Grand and petit jurors in courts of Guam shall receive the following fees, except as otherwise expressly provided by law:

For actual attendance at the place of trial or hearing and for the time necessarily occupied in going to and from such place at the beginning and end of such service or at any time during the same, \$20 per day, except that any juror required to attend more than thirty days in hearing one case may be paid at the discretion and upon the certification of the trial judge a per diem fee not exceeding \$25 each day in excess of thirty days he is required to hear such case.

Whenever in any case the jury is ordered to be kept together and not to separate, the cost of subsistence during such period shall be paid by the marshal upon the order of the court. Jury fees provided by this section shall be paid by the marshal on the certificate of the clerk of the court, and in the case of jury fees in excess of \$20 per diem, when allowed, as hereinabove provided, on the certificate of the trial judge.

(b) In all cases at law within the jurisdiction of the Island Court the recoverable cost for a trial by jury shall be \$10.00.''

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
