AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 680.11 AND SUBSECTION
2 OF SUBPARAGRAPH (b) OF SECTION 1038 OF THE
CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE TO ESTABLISH A PETIT
JURY FEE OF \$10.00.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 680.11 of the Code of Civil Procedure
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 680.11. Fees. (a) Grand and petit jurors in
5 courts of Guam shall receive the following fees, except
6 as otherwise expressly provided by law:

7 For actual attendance at the place of trial or hearing
8 and for the time necessarily occupied in going to and from
9 such place at the beginning and end of such service or at
10 any time during the same, \$20 per day, except that any juror
11 required to attend more than thirty days in hearing one
12 case may be paid at the discretion and upon the certifica-
13 tion of the trial judge a per diem fee not exceeding \$25
14 each day in excess of thirty days he is required to hear such
15 case.

16 Whenever in any case the jury is ordered to be kept
17 together and not to separate, the cost of subsistence
18 during such period shall be paid by the marshal upon
19 the order of the court. Jury fees provided by this section
20 shall be paid by the marshal on the certificate of the clerk
21 of the court, and in the case of jury fees in excess of
22 \$20 per diem, when allowed, as hereinabove provided, on
23 the certificate of the trial judge.

24 (b) In all cases at law within the jurisdiction of the
25 Island Court the recoverable cost for a trial by jury shall
26 be \$10.00."

1 Section 2. Subsection 2 of Subparagraph (b) of Section
2 1038 of the Code of Civil Procedure is hereby amended to read
3 as follows:

4 “2. All lawful fees charged against him for filing
5 records, issuing process, obtaining trial by jury, and
6 entering and docketing the action.”

7 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
