AN ACT TO ADD PARTICLE IVA TO CHAPTER IV OF PART IV OF DIVISION SECOND OF THE CIVIL CODE OF GUAM, AND TO AMEND SECTION 1189 OF SAID CODE, TO ADOPT THE UNIFORM RECOGNITION OF ACKNOWLEDGMENTS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Article IVa is hereby added to Chapter IV of Part IV of Division Second of the Civil Code of Guam to read as follows:

* ARTICLE IVa

Section 1208. Recognition of Notarial Acts Performed Outside Guam. For the purposes of this article, 'notarial acts' means acts which the laws and regulations of Guam authorize inotaries public of Guam to perform, including the administering of oaths and affirmations, taking proof of execution and acknowledgments of instruments, and attesting documents. Notarial acts may be performed outside Guam for use in Guam with the same effect as if performed by a notary public of Guam by the following persons authorized pursuant to the laws and regulations of other governments in addition to any other person authorized by the laws and regulations of Guam:

- (1) a notary public authorized to perform notarial acts in the place in which the act is performed;
- (2) a judge, clerk, or deputy clerk of any court of record in the place in which the notarial act is performed;
- (3) an officer of the foreign service of the United States, a consular agent, or any other person authorized by regulation of the United States Department of State to perform notarial acts in the place in which the act

the Armed Forces of the United States and any other 3 person authorized by regulation of the Armed Forces 4 to perform notarial acts if the notarial act is 5 performed for one of the following or his dependents: 5 a merchant seaman of the United States, a member of the 7 Armed Forces of the United States, or any other person 8 serving with or accompanying the Armed Forces of the 9 10 United States; or (5) any other person authorized to perform 11 notarial acts in the place in which the act is performed. 12 Section 1209. Authentication of Authority of Officer. 13 14 (a) If the notarial act is performed by any of the person described in paragraphs 1 to 4, inclusive 15 16 of Section 1208, other than a person authorized to perform notarial acts by the laws or regulations of 17 18 a foreign country, the signature, rank, or title and serial number, if any, of the person are sufficient 19 20 proof of the authority of a holder of that rank or title to perform the act. Further proof of his authority 21 is not required. 22 23 (b) If the notarial act is performed by a person authorized by the laws or regulations of a foreign 24 country to perform the act, there is sufficient proof 25 of the authority of that person to act if: 26 27 (1) either a foreign service officer of 25 the United States resident in the country in which 29 the act is performed or a diplomatic or consular 30 officer of the foreign country resident in the 31 United States certifies that a person holding that office is authorized to perform the act; 32 - 2 -

(4) a commissioned officer in active service with

1 (2) the official seal of the person performing 2 the notarial act is affixed to the document; or (3) the title and indication of authority to perform notarial acts of the person appears either in a digest of foreign law or in a list 5 customarily used as a source of such information. 6 7 (c) If the notarial act is performed by a person 8 . other than one described in Subsections (a) and (b), 9 there is sufficient proof of the authority of that person to act if the clerk of a court of record in 10 11 the place in which the notarial act is performed 12 certifies to the official character of that person and . 13 to his authority to perform the notarial act. (d) The signature and title of the person performing 14 the act are prima facie evidence that he is a person 15 with the designated title and that the signature 16 is genuine. 17 Section 1210. Certificate of Person Taking Acknowledg-18 ment. The person taking an acknowledgment shall certify 19 that: 20 21 (1) the person acknowledging appeared before him 22 and acknowledged he executed the instrument; and 23 (2) the person acknowledging was known to the 24 person taking the acknowledgment or that the person 25 taking the acknowledgment had satisfactory evidence 26 that the person acknowledging was the person described in and who executed the instrument. 27 Section 1211. Recognition of Certificate of Acknowledg-28 ment. The form of a certificate of acknowledgment used by 29 30 a person whose authority is recognized under Section 1209 shall be accepted in Guam if: 31 (1) the certificate is in a form prescribed by 32

the laws or regulations of Guam; 1 (2) the certificate is in a form prescribed by 2 the laws or regulations applicable in the place in 3 which the acknowledgment is taken; or 4 (3) the certificate contains the words "acknow-5 ledged before me, '' or their substantial equivalent. 6 Section 1212. Certificate of Acknowledgment. The 7 words "acknowledged before me" means 8 (1) that the person acknowledging appeared before 9 the person taking the acknowledgment, 10 (2) that he acknowledged he executed the instru-11 ment, 12 (3) that, in the case of: 13 (i) a natural person, he executed the instru-14 ment for the purposes therein stated; 15 (ii) a corporation, the officer or agent acknow-16 ledged he held the position or title set forth in 17 the instrument and certificate, he signed the ins-18 trument on behalf of the corporation by proper 19 authority, and the instrument was the act of the 20 corporation for the purpose therein stated; 21 (iii) a partnership, the partner or agent 22 acknowledged he signed the instrument on behalf 23 of the partnership by proper authority and he exe-24 cuted the instrument as the act of the partnership 25 for the purposed therein stated; 26 (iv) a person acknowledging as principal by 27 an attorney in fact, he executed the instrument 28 by proper authority as the act of the principal 29 for the purposes therein stated; 30 (v) a person acknowledging as a public officer, 31 trustee, administrator, guardian, or other 32 - 4 -

representative, he signed the instrument by proper authority and he executed the instrument in the capacity and for the purposes therein stated; and

(4) that the person taking the acknowledgment either knew or had satisfactory evidence that the person acknowledging was the person named in the instrument or certificate.

Section 1212.1. Short Forms of Acknowledgment. The forms of acknowledgment set forth in this section may be used and are sufficient for their respective purposes under any law of Guam. The forms shall be known as 'Statutory Short Forms of Acknowledgment' and may be referred to by that name. The authorization of the forms in this section does not preclude the use of other forms.

This article may be cited as the Uniform Recognition of Acknowledgments Act. '' 15 16 Section 2. Section 1189 of the Civil Code of Guam is hereby amended to read: 17 18 "Section 1189. The certificate 19 of acknowledgment, unless it is otherwise in this article provided, must be substantially in the following form: 20 Territory of Guam 21 22 On this ______ day of _____, in the year _____, before me (here insert name and quality of 23 the officer), personally appeared ____, known to me 24 (or proved to me on the oath of _____) to be the person 25 whose name is subscribed to the within instrument, and 26 27 acknowledged that he (she or they) executed the same: Provided, however, that any acknowledgment taken without 28 this territory in accordance with the laws of the place 29 where the acknowledgment is made, shall be sufficient in 30 Guam.'' 31 Section 3.
