AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 53552.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO RENAME THE TAMUNING INDUSTRIAL PARK AFTER THE LATE E. T. CALVO, FORMER LEGISLATOR, AND PROMINENT BUSINESS AND CIVIC LEADER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 53552.1 is hereby added to the
Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 53552.1. E. T. Calvo Memorial Park. That land belonging to the government of Guam and leased to the Corporation for use as a light industrial and commercial park is hereby designated the 'E. T. Calvo Memorial Park', after the late businessman and civic leader who contributed so materially to the economic development of the territory. The Governor, at such ceremony as he deems appropriate, is authorized to so officially name such park."

Section 2. This Act shall take effect September 1, 1970, at which time the dedication ceremony referred to hereinabove shall take place.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
