
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAST PARAGRAPH OF SECTION 4206 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REDUCE THE PERIOD FOR A GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE TO OBTAIN PRIOR SERVICE CREDIT BY CONTINUED EMPLOYMENT WITH THE GOVERNMENT FROM FIVE YEARS TO THREE YEARS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The last paragraph of Section 4206 of the
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Each member entitled to prior service credit shall
5 file with the Board, on a form prescribed by the Board
6 and under such rules as it may adopt, a detailed statement
7 of all such prior service for which the member claims
8 credit. Such claim shall be verified by the Board as
9 soon as practicable after the filing thereof. Upon such
10 verification, the Board shall cause to be issued a state-
11 ment of prior service, certifying to the member the
12 length of prior service for which credit has been granted.
13 Such statement shall be final and conclusive for the
14 purposes of the Fund as to such service, except for the
15 correction of error, provided that any member may, within
16 one year from the date of original issuance of such
17 certificate, request the Board to modify or correct such
18 prior service certificate. Such certificate shall become
19 null and void upon the death of a member, and shall be
20 cancelled automatically upon receipt by a member of a
21 refund of his contributions. Such certificate may be
22 reinstated only under the conditions prescribed by the
23 provisions of this Chapter. Any employee who shall not

be in service on the operative date, or who is on an approved leave of absence on such date, for disability, military leave or other cause, shall be entitled to receive credit for prior service only when such employee shall have completed at least three years of contributing membership service subsequent to the operative date."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
