



AN ACT TO RENAME AGAFU GUMAS MACHANANAO  
VILLAGE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Statement of legislative findings. The  
3 Legislature finds that the area known since the Second World  
4 War as Agafu Gumas is actually located in that part of Guam  
5 that in pre-war days was known as Machananao. The Legislature  
6 further finds that it is in the public interest to preserve  
7 all Guam place names, particularly one with as ancient a  
8 public record as Machananao.

9 Section 2. Renaming Agafu Gumas. That part of the  
10 municipality of Yigo referred to as "Agafu Gumas" is hereby  
11 officially renamed "Machananao Village" and henceforth all maps,  
12 documents, and other public records shall refer to such area  
13 under its new name.
