




AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 4019 AND 4020
OF CHAPTER 1, TITLE V, GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE GOVERN-
MENT INSURANCE PROGRAM TO SURVIVORS OF
RETIRED EMPLOYEES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4019, Chapter 1, Title V, Government
3 Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4019. Group Insurance. (a) The Governor
5 is authorized to enter contracts with one or more insurance
6 companies, authorized to do business in Guam, for group
7 insurance, including but not limited to hospitalization,
8 medical care, life, and accident, for all employees
9 or separate groups of employees of the Government Code
10 of Guam.

11 (b) All participation by employees in such contracts
12 of insurance shall be on a voluntary basis, and all
13 premiums for any such policies shall be paid 50% by the
14 Government of Guam and 50% by the employees participating
15 by payroll deductions.

16 (c) Contracts of insurance procured under the fore-
17 going may provide for participation by employees of the
18 Legislative and Judicial Branches, or such branches may
19 enter separate contracts for their employees subject to the
20 limitations set forth in this section.

21 (d) As used in this section, 'employees' includes
22 officers, and retired employees and survivors of retired
23 employees who are receiving annuity benefits."

1 Section 2. Section 4020, Chapter 1, Title V, Government
2 Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 4020. Group Life Insurance. (a) The
4 Governor is authorized to enter into contract with one or
5 more insurance companies authorized to do business in
6 Guam for Group Life Insurance for all employees or
7 separate groups of employees of the government of Guam.

8 (b) All participation by employees in such contracts
9 of life insurance shall be on a voluntary basis and one-
10 half of all premiums for any such policy shall be paid
11 by employees participating and the remaining half shall
12 be paid for by the government of Guam. The government of
13 Guam shall also provide payroll deductions for the pay-
14 ment of premiums.

15 (c) Contracts of insurance procured under the fore-
16 going shall be limited to a face amount of Five Thousand
17 Dollars (\$5,000.00) except that double indemnity may be
18 allowed to those who elect to pay the additional premium.

19 (d) 'Employees' as used in this section includes
20 officers and retired employees and survivors of retired
21 employees who are receiving annuity benefits."

22 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
