AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONSTRUCT SUBDIVISIONS IN THE PAGACHAO AREA IN AGAT, AND IN SANTA RITA, AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF LOTS THEREAT AT LESS THAN FAIR MARKET VALUE AND SETTING UP PRIORITIES IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH SALES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) to the Department of Public Works to subdivide into residential subdivisions of no less than 100 lots, each of which shall measure no less than 60 feet by 90 feet the Pagachao area of Agat (Lots Nos. 350 and 194-2-3) and a suitable area of government land in the municipality of Santa Rita.

Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law (including the provisions of Chapter 6, Title XIV of the Government Code of Guam) with respect to the sale of government land, the Governor is authorized to sell lots in the foregoing subdivisions in the municipality of Agat and Santa Rita, at less than the fair market value of the lots and at less than the cost expended by the government of Guam in developing and improving said lots.

Section 3. In carrying out the mandate of this Act, the Governor shall observe the following priorities in so selling said lots at less than fair market value:

> (1) First preference shall be given to those purchasers who reside in the municipalities of Agat or Santa

Rita, prior to the enactment of this Act, and are without fee title to any real property of their own upon which safe, sanitary and decent housing could be erected;

(2) Second preference shall be given to those purchasers who are without fee title to any real property who are bona fide residents of Guam.

In solling said lots, the Governor may accept in payment land in Agat or Santa Rita, if any, belonging to the buyer, the value of the land so exchanged by the buyer to be taken from the value set out in the most current real property tax assessment roll.

Section 4. In any contract of sale or deed of conveyance executed as a result of the provisions of this Act. a covenant shall be included whereby the purchaser-grantee agrees that any residential building erected on the lot the subject of the contract or deed shall be constructed in conformity with the residential construction requirements of the Guam Housing Corporation in effect at the time of the construction.

Section 5. The Governor is authorized to promulgate by Executive Order necessary rules and regulations to effect the purpose of this Act which the Legislature declares to be that of providing suitable residential building lots in the municipalities of Agat and Santa Rita to those who badly need the same, the legislature finding that the serious overcrowding of the municipalities of Agat and Santa Rita endangers the health, safety, and well-being of the residents of Agat and Santa Rita and necessitates their being given an opportunity to acquire suitable residential building lots in a government subdivision.

Section 6. With respect to the government of Guam residential subdivision at As-Tumbo in the municipality of Dededo, the provisions of this Act shall apply to sales of lots therein, except that the priorities set out in Section 3 of this Act shall be deemed to refer to the residents of Dededo.

Section 7. This Act is an urgency measure.
