AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (c) OF SECTION  
13507 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO  
REQUIRE NEWSPAPER PUBLICATION OF APPLICATION  
FOR THE SALE OR TRANSFER OF GOVERNMENT LAND.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (c) of Section 13507 of the  
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 " (c) At least thirty days notice of such public  
5 hearing shall be given to the applicant, the public of  
6 Guam, the Governor, and all heads of departments and  
7 agencies of the government of Guam. Such notice shall be  
8 in the form prescribed by rule of the Board and shall  
9 contain the time and place of the hearing, the name and  
10 address of the applicant, the description of the land  
11 applied for, and such other information as the Board  
12 considers appropriate. Notice to the applicant may  
13 require the applicant to attend. Notice to the public  
14 shall be given by publication in a daily newspaper of  
15 general circulation in Guam at least once a week for  
16 three successive weeks which published notice shall  
17 include the names of all parties to the proposed trans-  
18 action, the proposed purchase price or annual rent, and  
19 a general summary of the boundaries of the tract or  
20 tracts proposed to be included in the conveyance. Notice  
21 to heads of departments and agencies of the government  
22 of Guam may provide that unless objection is made or  
23 information furnished by such departments and agencies  
24 at or before the public hearing, the Board will presume  
25 that the land applied for is not in use by and not  
26 essential for the use of such departments and agencies."  
27 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
