AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (c) OF SECTION 13507 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE NEWSPAPER PUBLICATION OF APPLICATION FOR THE SALE OR TRANSFER OF GOVERNMENT LAND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Subparagraph (c) of Section 13507 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "(c) At least thirty days notice of such public hearing shall be given to the applicant, the public of Guam, the Governor, and all heads of departments and agencies of the government of Guam. Such notice shall be in the form prescribed by rule of the Board and shall contain the time and place of the hearing, the name and address of the applicant, the description of the land applied for, and such other information as the Board considers appropriate. Notice to the applicant may require the applicant to attend. Notice to the public shall be given by publication in a daily newspaper of general circulation in Guam at least once a week for three successive weeks which published notice shall include the names of all parties to the proposed transaction, the proposed purchase price or annual rent, and a general summary of the boundaries of the tract or tracts proposed to be included in the conveyance, Notice to heads of departments and agencies of the government of Guam may provide that unless objection is made or information furnished by such departments and agencies at or before the public hearing, the Board :will presume that the land applied for is not in use by and not essential for the use of such departments and agencies." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
