


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This certifies that Bill No. 120, "An Act making appropriations to the legislature for the construction of offices and to furnish the same", was on the 28th day of January, 1971, duly and regularly passed.

Section 2. There is appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territory of Guam the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) for the construction of offices.

Section 3. There is appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territory of Guam the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for the construction of offices.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE  
LEGISLATURE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF  
OFFICES AND TO FURNISH THE SAME.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
4 sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) to the Legislature for  
5 the construction of offices.

6 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
7 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
8 of Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000) to the Legislature to  
9 furnish the Guam Congress Building and other offices of the  
10 Legislature.

11 Section 3. All expenditures under Section 2 shall be made  
12 only upon public bid, and only upon the contract or contracts  
13 being awarded to the person or persons submitting the lowest  
14 acceptable bid to the Executive Committee of the Legislature.

15 Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
