AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 1., VI., ITEM B., OF PUBLIC LAW 10-171, TENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE TO REDUCE THE APPROPRIATION FOR PARK DEVE-LOPMENT, AND MAKING APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE RESTROOM FACILITIES AT THE SURFING BEACH AREA IN TALOFOFO BAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 1., VI., Item B., of Public Law 10-171, Tenth Guam Legislature, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"B. Park Development

## \$83,000"

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) to construct restroom facilities in the surfing beach area in Talofofo Bay; provided, however, that in the event that construction is not completed within ten (10) months, said funds shall revert to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
