




AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION  
FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE TENTH GUAM  
LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
4 of Two Hundred Five Thousand, Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$205,089),  
5 to supplement the previous appropriation made to the Legislature  
6 by Section 1, I., Q., of Public Law 10-169, Tenth Guam Legislature.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
