




AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO
CONSTRUCT A PUBLIC LIBRARY IN MERIZO.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any
3 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
4 Fund the sum of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000) for the
5 construction of a public library building in the village of
6 Merizo, such sum to include any Federal grant-in-aid under
7 Title II of the Library Services and Construction Act for
8 the fiscal years 1970 and 1971.

9 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
