






AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 7 TO TITLE II OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE THE  
COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH OF THE  
LEGISLATURE TO CONDUCT AN ANNUAL LEGISLA-  
TIVE CONFERENCE ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter 7 is hereby added to Title II  
3 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Chapter 7

5 Annual Legislative Conference on Children  
6 and Youth

7 Section 1600. Committee on Children and Youth to  
8 conduct a conference. The Committee on Children and  
9 Youth, or its successor, of the Legislature, on behalf  
10 of the Legislature, is authorized to conduct an annual  
11 conference in the territory of Guam for the purpose of  
12 examining the problems and aspirations of the young people  
13 of Guam. The conference shall be known as the Legislative  
14 Conference on Children and Youth and shall be held at  
15 the Guam Congress Building or such other place within  
16 Guam as the Committee determines.

17 Section 1601. Scope of conference. The Legislative  
18 Conference on Children and Youth shall be conducted in  
19 such a manner as to permit an opportunity for meaningful  
20 dialogue among the youth of Guam, their mentors, and  
21 their senators, it being hereby declared that the purpose  
22 of such conference is to provide the Legislature with

1 useable data and up-to-date information on the problems  
2 facing the youth of Guam so that substantive legislation,  
3 if needed, can be enacted.

4 Section 1602. Authorization of appropriation.

5 There is hereby authorized to be appropriated annually  
6 the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) to the  
7 Committee on Children and Youth, or its successor, of  
8 the Legislature, for the purpose of conducting the  
9 annual Legislative Conference on Children and Youth."

10 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
