




AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
JUDICIARY FOR NECESSARY CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated  
3 from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of  
4 the General Fund for the following capital improvements:

5 A. Carpeting of Courtrooms \$ 6,300.00

6 B. Typhoon Shutters for the Courthouse 6,000.00

7 C. Floor Tiling of Girls' Dormitory

8 at YCF 320.00

9 D. Painting of Youth Facilities 600.00

10 Section 2. Every appropriation made herein shall continue  
11 in full force and effect until expended for the purpose for  
12 which made or until the project is completed.

13 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
