
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 101a TO THE  
CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE, AUTHORIZING  
ASSIGNMENT OF ISLAND COURT JUDGES TO THE  
POLICE COURT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 101a is hereby added to the Code  
3 of Civil Procedure of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 101a. Assignment of Island Court judges  
5 to the Police Court as additional duty. If the judge of  
6 the Police Court is absent, disabled, disqualified or if  
7 the Chief Judge of the Island Court determines that the  
8 proper dispatch of the business of the Police Court so  
9 requires, the Chief Judge may assign one or more judges  
10 of the Island Court to the Police Court to act as a  
11 judge or judges of the Police Court; provided, however,  
12 that no judge of the Island Court may be assigned to the  
13 Police Court without his consent."

14 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
