AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 101a TO THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE, AUTHORIZING ASSIGNMENT OF ISLAND COURT JUDGES TO THE POLICE COURT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. A new Section 101a is hereby added to the Code of Civil Procedure of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 101a. Assignment of Island Court judges to the Police Court as additional duty. If the judge of the Police Court is absent, disabled, disqualified or if the Chief Judge of the Island Court determines that the proper dispatch of the business of the Police Court so requires, the Chief Judge may assign one or more judges of the Island Court to the Police Court to act as a judge or judges of the Police Court; provided, however, that no judge of the Island Court may be assigned to the Police Court without his consent."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
