




AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR
TRAINING A TRACK AND FIELD TEAM FOR
THE 1971 SOUTH PACIFIC GAMES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
4 of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) to the Department of Education
5 to train the Guam track and field team for the 1971 South Pacific
6 Games.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
