




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION
FOR THE OFFICE OF GUAM'S WASHINGTON
REPRESENTATIVE FOR CALENDAR YEAR ENDING
DECEMBER 31, 1971.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any
3 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
4 Fund the sum of Sixty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$69,000) to
5 supplement the appropriation made by Section 5 of Public Law
6 10-169, Tenth Guam Legislature, to the Office of Guam's
7 Washington Representative for the operation of said Office for
8 the calendar year ending December 31, 1971.

9 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
