

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 24200 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE
HEARING AND NOTICE IN THE ADOPTION OF
RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 24200 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 24200. Adoption of rules. In addition
5 to other rule-making requirements imposed by law:

6 (1) Each agency shall adopt rules governing the
7 formal and informal procedures prescribed or authorized
8 by this Act. Such rules shall include rules of practice
9 before the agency, together with forms and instructions.

10 (2) To assist interested persons dealing with it,
11 each agency shall so far as deemed practicable supple-
12 ment its rules with descriptive statements of its
13 procedures.

14 (3) Prior to the adoption of any rule authorized
15 by law, or the amendment or repeal thereof, the adopt-
16 ing agency shall hold a public hearing thereon to
17 afford interested persons an opportunity to submit
18 data or views orally or in writing. Notice for such
19 hearing shall be published at least once at least ten
20 days before the date of the hearing in a newspaper of
21 general circulation on Guam, shall contain the place
22 and time of the proposed hearing, and a brief descrip-
23 tion of the agency's intended action."

24 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
