






AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11876 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCLUDE
GRADUATE STUDENTS WITHIN THE TEACHER
TRAINEE PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF
GUAM AND TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY STIPENDS
GIVEN SUCH STUDENTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11876 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 11876. Program. (a) There is hereby
5 established in the University of Guam a program for
6 the selection of teacher-trainees to carry on under-
7 graduate and graduate courses of study, including
8 attendance during both regular semesters and summer
9 sessions leading to a Bachelor of Arts and Masters
10 degrees in Education.

11 (b) Unmarried undergraduate trainees shall
12 receive a monthly allowance in the amount of one
13 hundred dollars (\$100.00) during the freshman year,
14 one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) during
15 the sophomore year,, two hundred dollars (\$200.00)

1 during the junior year, and two hundred dollars
2 (\$200.00) during the senior year of the program.
3 Married undergraduate trainees shall receive a
4 monthly allowance of one hundred twenty-five
5 dollars (\$125.00) during the freshman year, one
6 hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) during the sopho-
7 more year, three hundred dollars (\$300.00) during
8 the junior year, and three hundred dollars (\$300.00)
9 during the senior year of the program. Unmarried
10 graduate trainees shall receive a monthly allowance
11 in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)
12 during their participation in the program, and
13 married graduate trainees shall receive a monthly
14 allowance of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) during
15 their participation in the program. Registration,
16 tuition and other fees normally assessed shall not
17 be charged, and a credit allowance in an amount not
18 to exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) shall be
19 allowed for each six (6) months to cover the cost
20 of textbooks and supplies."

21 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
