AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11876 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCLUDE GRADUATE STUDENTS WITHIN THE TEACHER TRAINEE PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AND TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY STIPENDS GIVEN SUCH STUDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11876 of the Government Code of Guam
is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 11876. Program. (a) There is hereby established in the University of Guam a program for the selection of teacher-trainees to carry on undergraduate and graduate courses of study, including attendance during both regular semesters and summer sessions leading to a Bachelor of Arts and Masters degrees in Education.

(b) Unmarried undergraduate trainees shall receive a monthly allowance in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) during the freshman year, one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) during the sophomore year, two hundred dollars (\$200.00)

during the junior year, and two hundred dollars (\$200.00) during the senior year of the program. Married undergraduate trainees shall receive a monthly allowance of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) during the freshman year, one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) during the sophomore year, three hundred dollars (\$300.00) during the junior year, and three hundred dollars (\$300.00) during the senior year of the program. Unmarried graduate trainees shall receive a monthly allowance in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) during their participation in the program, and married graduate trainees shall receive a monthly allowance of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) during their participation in the program. Registration, tuition and other fees normally assessed shall not be charged, and a credit allowance in an amount not to exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) shall be allowed for each six (6) months to cover the cost of textbooks and supplies."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
