AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUMMER
YOUTH EMPLOYMENT UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE
GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON RECREATION AND YOUTH
AND TO REAPPROPRIATE THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE
OF STUDENT SUMMER EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM ACCOUNT
NO. 6048 TO THE UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS OF THE
GENERAL FUND AND TO APPROPRIATE TO THE GUAM
MUSIC EDUCATORS ASSOCIATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
4 of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to the Governor's
5 Committee on Recreation and Youth for the purpose of providing
6 summer employment for students of the various public and private
7 schools in Guam who are at least sixteen (16) years of age, such
8 students to be employed during the summer period, between school
9 terms by the government of Guam or private enterprise approved
10 by the Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth.

11 Students employed under this program shall receive Workmen's
12 Compensation, but shall not be eligible for any of the retire-
13 ment, sick leave, or annual leave benefits applicable to regular
14 employees of the government or private enterprise, except as
15 may be specifically provided.

1 The employer, whether the government or private enterprise,
2 shall be responsible for paying such students at the rate of
3 One Dollar (\$1.00) per hour. Upon making application therefor
4 private enterprise shall receive from the Governor's Committee
5 on Recreation and Youth the sum of Fifty Cents (\$.50) for every
6 dollar paid to such students.

7 The Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth shall
8 make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out
9 the purposes of this Act.

10 Section 2. Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000) of the
11 appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act shall take effect
12 upon approval hereof.

13 Section 3. One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000)
14 of the appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act shall take
15 effect July 1, 1971.

16 Section 4. The unencumbered balance of the Student Summer
17 Employment Program Account No. 6048 in the sum of \$39,685.66 is
18 hereby appropriated to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
19 Fund of the government of Guam.

20 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available
21 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
22 of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to the Guam Music Educators
23 Association for the purpose of helping to send the Guam Junior
24 High School students honor choir and band to Saipan to entertain
25 the Saipan school students.

26 Section 6. This Act is an urgency measure.

1 The employer, whether the government or private enterprise,
2 shall be responsible for paying such students at the rate of
3 One Dollar (\$1.00) per hour. Upon making application therefor
4 private enterprise shall receive from the Governor's Committee
5 on Recreation and Youth the sum of Fifty Cents (\$.50) for every
6 dollar paid to such students.

7 The Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth shall
8 make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out
9 the purposes of this Act.

10 Section 2. Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000) of the
11 appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act shall take effect
12 upon approval hereof.

13 Section 3. One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000)
14 of the appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act shall take
15 effect July 1, 1971.

16 Section 4. The unencumbered balance of the Student Summer
17 Employment Program Account No. 6048 in the sum of \$39,685.66 is
18 hereby appropriated to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
19 Fund of the government of Guam.

20 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available
21 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
22 of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to the Guam Music Educators
23 Association for the purpose of helping to send the Guam Junior
24 High School students honor choir and band to Saipan to entertain
25 the Saipan school students.

26 Section 6. This Act is an urgency measure.
