AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 49016 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THAT HOSPITAL PATIENTS' RECORDS BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 49016 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 49016. Patients' records confidential.

Patients' medical records are confidential and copies
thereof may be released only upon the written consent
of the patient involved or by written order of the
District Court of Guam or of the Island Court of
Guam."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
