



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Bill No. 63, "An Act to add a new Section 49016 to the Government Code of Guam to require that hospital patients' records be kept confidential", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on April 23, 1971, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 26th day of April, 1971, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of more than two-thirds of all of the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 15 members.







Introduced by J. B. Butler

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 49016 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THAT
HOSPITAL PATIENTS' RECORDS BE KEPT
CONFIDENTIAL.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 49016 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 49016. Patients' records confidential.
5 Patients' medical records are confidential and copies
6 thereof may be released only upon the written consent
7 of the patient involved or by written order of the
8 District Court of Guam or of the Island Court of
9 Guam."

10 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
