AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (a) OF SECTION 11996 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT FOR SECULAR EDUCATIONAL SERVICES ON A QUARTERLY BASIS IN THE FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THE EXPENDITURES WERE INCURRED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subparagraph (a) of Section 11996 of the

Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) Requests for reimbursement in payment for the purchase of secular educational conditions hereunder shall be made on such forms and under such conditions as the Director of Education shall prescribe. Any nonpublic school seeking such reimbursement shall maintain such accounting procedures, including maintenance of separate funds and accounts pertaining to the cost of secular educational service, as to establish that it actually expended in support of such service an amount of money equal to the amount of money sought in reimbursement. Such accounts shall be

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1	subject to audit by the government of Guam. Reimburse-
2	ment payments shall be made by the Director as follows:
3	(i) On December 15th for expenditures made
4	in the months of September, October
5	and November of the same year;
6	(ii) On March 15th for expenditures made in
7	the months of December of the prior year
8	and January and February of the same year;
9	(iii) On June 15th for expenditures made in the
10	months of March, April and May of the
11	same year;
12	(iv) On September 15th for expenditures made
13	in the months of June, July and August of
14	the same year."
15	Section 2. Disbursements of all amounts which are pre-
16	sently due and payable pursuant to the provisions of this Act
17	shall be made within 15 days after approval of this Act by the
18	Governor.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.

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
