AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 201 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PREVENT THE FRIDAY PRECEDING A PRIMARY OR RUN-OFF ELECTION FROM BECOMING A HOLIDAY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 201 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 201. Same. If any of the holidays . enumerated in Section 200, (b) through (o), inclusive, falls upon a Sunday, the following-Monday is a holiday, and if any of such holidays falls upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a holiday; provided, however, that if the holiday results from a primary election or a run-off election held upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday is ·not a holiday."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
