


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Bill No. 231

Introduced by F. R. Santos

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 201 OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PREVENT  
THE FRIDAY PRECEDING A PRIMARY OR  
RUN-OFF ELECTION FROM BECOMING A  
HOLIDAY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 201 of the Government Code of Guam is  
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 201. Same. If any of the holidays  
5 enumerated in Section 200, (b) through (o), inclusive,  
6 falls upon a Sunday, the following Monday is a  
7 holiday, and if any of such holidays falls upon a  
8 Saturday, the preceding Friday is a holiday;  
9 provided, however, that if the holiday results  
10 from a primary election or a run-off election  
11 held upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday is  
12 not a holiday."

13 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
