


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO  
INSTALL A TEMPORARY WATERLINE BETWEEN  
UMATAC AND AGAT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any avail-  
3 able funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund  
4 the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to provide for the  
5 installation of a temporary waterline between the villages of  
6 Umatac and Agat.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
