AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (b) OF SECTION 680.1 OF THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE OF GUAM TO LIMIT THE RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL IN CRIMINAL CASES TO SERIOUS OFFENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subparagraph (b) of Section 680.1 of the Code

of Civil Procedure of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(b) Right to jury trial. In all cases at law in which the demand, exclusive of interest and costs, or the value of the property in controversy, amounts to more than \$20.00, and in all criminal cases within the jurisdiction of the Island Court or of the District Court, the parties shall be entitled to a trial by jury. Provided however, that in all cases where the authorized punishment does not exceed six (6) months imprisonment, the granting of a trial by jury shall be within the sole discretion of the trial judge."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
