




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Bill No. 90, "An Act to amend Section 13952 of the Government Code of Guam to require subdivisions of government land to conform to the provisions of the Subdivision Law and to require statutory authorization for each such subdivision", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on April 19, 1971, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 28th day of April, 1971, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of more than two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 16 members.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13952 OF THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE SUBDIVISIONS OF GOVERN-  
MENT LAND TO CONFORM TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE  
SUBDIVISION LAW AND TO REQUIRE STATUTORY AUTHO-  
RIZATION FOR EACH SUCH SUBDIVISION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13952 of the Government Code of Guam  
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 13952. Government subdivisions. The  
5 Director, with the approval of the Governor, may  
6 designate and plan subdivisions in conformity with  
7 the provisions of Title XIX, Government Code of  
8 Guam, in, adjacent to, or near any village. Govern-  
9 ment real property may be used for this purpose or  
10 privately owned property may be acquired by purchase,  
11 exchange or condemnation. No such land, however, may  
12 be subdivided unless such subdivision is specifically  
13 authorized by statute which statute shall require

1 such subdivision to conform to the minimum standards  
2 of the Subdivision Law set forth in Title XIX of  
3 this Code and cite the purpose, location and size of  
4 the proposed subdivision, and the standards and  
5 criteria to be used for sale or other disposition  
6 of lots thereat. The Department of Public Works  
7 shall be responsible for the construction of the  
8 necessary improvements of any such subdivision.  
9 The Department of Public Works may perform the  
10 necessary work and construction therefor upon  
11 submitting to the Director on the basis of com-  
12 petitive bidding a bid and completion date equal  
13 to or less than that of a private contractor.  
14 Otherwise the Department of Public Works shall  
15 contract for such work and construction in whole  
16 or in part to the private contractor submitting  
17 the successful competitive bid."

18 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
