AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13952 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE SUBDIVISIONS OF GOVERNMENT LAND TO CONFORM TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE SUBDIVISION LAW AND TO REQUIRE STATUTORY AUTHORIZATION FOR EACH SUCH SUBDIVISION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 13952 of the Government Code of Guam
is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 13952. Government subdivisions. The Director, with the approval of the Governor, may designate and plan subdivisions in conformity with the provisions of Title XIX, Government Code of Guam, in, adjacent to, or near any village. Government real property may be used for this purpose or privately owned property may be acquired by purchase, exchange or condemnation. No such land, however, may be subdivided unless such subdivision is specifically authorized by statute which statute shall require

such subdivision to conform to the minimum standards of the Subdivision Law set forth in Title XIX of this code and cite the purpose, location and size of the proposed subdivision, and the standards and criteria to be used for sale or other disposition of lots thereat. The Department of Public Works shall be responsible for the construction of the necessary improvements of any such subdivision. The Department of Public Works may perform the necessary work and construction therefor upon submitting to the Director on the basis of competitive bidding a bid and completion date equal to or less than that of a private contractor. Otherwise the Department of Public Works shall contract for such work and construction in whole or in part to the private contractor submitting the successful competitive bid."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
