


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR VARIOUS
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from
3 any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
4 Fund for various capital improvements and for other purposes:

5 I. For General Government

6 A. Automotive replacement \$ 39,000
7 B. Heavy equipment replacement 45,500

8 II. For Public Safety

9 A. Acquisition of fire fighting
10 equipment 206,000
11 B. Construction of Inarajan police
12 and fire station 45,000
13 C. Installation of fire hydrants at
14 Mongmong 12,000

15 III. For Highways

16 A. Widening of Marine Drive 100,000
17 B. Street lights - Asan 570

18 IV. For Education

19 A. Treatment of school buildings for
20 termites 25,000
21 B. Purchase of air conditioner
22 (Telecommunications) 3,000

23 V. For Utilities and Other Enterprises

24 A. Investigation of water - southern
25 districts 20,000

1 B. Preliminary design for sewage

2 treatment plant

12,000

3 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
4 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
5 of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for the Guam Combat
6 Patrol Veterans Bonuses to carry out the provision of Public Law
7 10-101, Tenth Guam Legislature.

8 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
9 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
10 of One Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-One
11 Dollars (\$186,791) for contribution to the Land Acquisition Fund
12 to pay for unpaid judgments in land condemnation cases and for
13 acquisition of properties for access road and water well site.

14 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available
15 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
16 of Twenty-One Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Six Dollars (\$21,346)
17 for payment of claims against the government for damage of pro-
18 perties, injuries and other such claims.

19 Section 5. All appropriations made by Sections 1, 2, 3,
20 and 4, shall be effective immediately and shall be available for
21 all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every
22 appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect
23 until expended for the purpose for which made or until the project
24 is completed.

25 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available
26 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
27 of One Million Five Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred
28 Twenty-Three Dollars and Thirty-Three Cents (\$1,569,423.33) as the
29 fifth and sixth payments toward reimbursing the Federal Government
30 for principal and interest pursuant to Public Law 88-170.

31 Section 7. This Act is an urgency measure.
