AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for various capital improvements and for other purposes: I. For General Government Automotive replacement 39,000 A. \$ ł Heavy equipment replacement в. 45,500 II. For Public Safety Acquisition of fire fighting Α. equipment 206,000 B. Construction of Inarajan police and fire station 12 45,000 C. Installation of fire hydrants at 12,000 Mongmong III. For Highways A. Widening of Marine Drive 100,000 570 17 Street lights - Asan в. IV. For Education A. Treatment of school buildings for termites 25,000 B. Purchase of air conditioner (Telecommunications) 3,000 23 V. For Utilities and Other Enterprises A. Investigation of water - southern districts 20,000

B. Preliminary design for sewage

treatment plant

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for the Guam Combat Patrol Veterans Bonuses to carry out the provision of Public Law 10-101, Tenth Guam Legislature.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-One Dollars (\$186,791) for contribution to the Land Acquisition Fund to pay for unpaid judgments in land condemnation cases and for acquisition of properties for access road and water well site.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-One Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Six Dollars (\$21,346) for payment of claims against the government for damage of properties, injuries and other such claims.

Section 5. All appropriations made by Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4, shall be effective immediately and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect until expended for the purpose for which made or until the project is completed.

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Million Five Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars and Thirty-Three Cents (\$1,569,423.33) as the fifth and sixth payments toward reimbursing the Federal Government for principal and interest pursuant to Public Law 88-170.

Section 7. This Act is an urgency measure.
