



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by J. A. Perez

AN ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 21505.1, 21505.2, AND 21505.3 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT TO THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY OF AN ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER FOR ENGINEERING AND TECHNICAL SERVICES AND AN ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER FOR ADMINISTRATION AND FISCAL SERVICES, AND ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER FOR OPERATIONS AND DISTRIBUTION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 21505.1 is hereby added to the Govern-
3 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 21505.1. Assistant General Manager for
5 Engineering and Technical Services.

6 (a) The General Manager, with the consent of the
7 Board, shall appoint an Assistant General Manager for
8 Engineering and Technical Services, who shall serve at
9 the pleasure of the General Manager and the Board.

10 (b) The Assistant General Manager for Engineering
11 and Technical Services shall be entitled to receive com-
12 pensation to be determined by the General Manager with
13 the approval of the Board.

14 (c) Such Assistant General Manager shall devote
15 his entire time to the business of the Authority, and
16 shall have full charge and control, subject to the
17 control of the General Manager and the Board, of all
18 engineering and technical services of the Authority.

19 (d) Such Assistant General Manager shall have such
20 other duties as may be designated by the General Manager."

21 Section 2. Section 21505.2 is hereby added to the Govern-
22 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

23 "Section 21505.2. Assistant General Manager for
24 Administration and Fiscal Services.

1 (a) The General Manager, with the consent of the
2 Board, shall appoint an Assistant General Manager for
3 Administration and Fiscal Services, who shall serve
4 at the pleasure of the General Manager and the Board.

5 (b) The Assistant General Manager for Administra-
6 tion and Fiscal Services shall be entitled to receive
7 compensation to be determined by the General Manager
8 with the approval of the Board.

9 (c) Such Assistant General Manager shall devote
10 his entire time to the business of the Authority, and
11 shall have full charge and control, subject to the
12 control of the General Manager and the Board, of all
13 administration, accounting and fiscal services of the
14 Authority.

15 (d) Such Assistant General Manager shall have such
16 other duties as may be designated by the General Manager."
17 Section 3. Section 21505.3 is hereby added to the Govern-
18 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

19 "Section 21505.3. Assistant General Manager for
20 Operations and Distribution.

21 (a) The General Manager with the consent of the
22 Board shall appoint an Assistant General Manager for
23 Operations and Distribution who shall serve at the
24 pleasure of the General Manager and the Board.

25 (b) The Assistant General Manager for Operations
26 and Distribution shall be entitled to receive compensa-
27 tion to be determined by the General Manager with the
28 approval of the Board.

29 (c) Such Assistant General Manager shall devote
30 his entire time to the business of the Authority, and
31 shall have full charge and control, subject to the
32 control of the General Manager and the Board of all

operation and distribution of the Authority.

(d) Such Assistant General Manager shall have such other duties as may be designated by the General Manager."
