AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF BLEACHERS AT THE UMATAC BASKETBALL COURT AND FOR A BASEBALL FIELD AND BACKSTOP IN UMATAC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000) of which Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000) shall be used for the construction of bleachers at the Umatac basketball field and Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for the construction of a baseball field and backstop in Umatac.
