AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for various capital improvements and for other purposes:

For Highways

- A. Talofofo Bay Emergency Repair: This appropriation is to repair damage done by Tropical Storm Patsy resulting wave action that washed out a considerable portion of the beach area and threatened Route 4.
- B. Paasan Avenue: The purpose of this appropriation is to pave with hot, concrete asphalt at this location, near the low-rent housing in the municipality of Sinajana: The distance considered for this project is approximately half a mile.

For Public Safety

A. Igloo Renovation for Typhoon Shelter: To provide concrete flooring, water, power and restroom facilities.

For Education

A. Construction of cafeteria and food service training building and equipment: The purpose of this appropriation is to construct a 70'x60' building (4200 sq. ft.) for the Guam Vocational and Technical High School. This cafeteria will alleviate the present problem of hot lunches being prepared at GWHS with transportation furnished by Barrigada Jr. High to be served at Guam Vocational & Technical High. GWHS is experiencing increased enrollment each year and this will lessen the problem. An added advantage is the proposed plan by Guam Vocational & Technical High School to utilize this facility to train students in food preparation and serving, snack bar operation, hosting and cashier-manager to offset the acute labor shortage in this profession. B. Harmon Loop Elementary School Access Road: This approved appropriation is to provide access road to the Harmon Loop Elementary School which is scheduled to open for classes in September, 1971.

For General Government

Construction of Training Building: The \$76,000 will construct a 30'x80' reinforced-steel training building for the bus drivers of the Department of Public Works. This request has been made several times and the urgency of the construction of said training building is imminent.
