AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 10-134 TO INCREASE THE AUTHORIZATION FOR APPROPRIATION FOR THE VILLAGE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT FUND AND TO ADD THE MUNICIPA-LITY OF DEDEDO AS A MUNICIPALITY ENTITLED TO THE BENEFITS THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law 10-134, Tenth Guam Legislature, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Village Drainage Fund. There is hereby created the Drainage Improvement Fund to be used to finance village drainage system pursuant to this Act. There is authorized to be appropriated to said Fund from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$3,707,000 to be apportioned among the municipal districts of Guam as follows: Municipality Amount
