


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION  
FOR THE LEGISLATIVE AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR  
ENDING JUNE 30, 1970, AND TO MAKE APPRO-  
PRIATIONS FOR THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITS FOR  
FISCAL YEARS ENDING JUNE 30, 1971, AND  
FOR JUNE 30, 1972.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any avail-  
3 able funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund  
4 the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to the Legislature  
5 to supplement the appropriation made by Section 4 of Public  
6 Law 10-171, Tenth Guam Legislature, for the legislative audit  
7 of the accounts and financial transactions of the government  
8 of Guam for fiscal year ending June 30, 1970.

9 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this  
10 Act shall be effective immediately.

11 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any avail-  
12 able funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
13 sum of One Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$145,000) to the  
14 Legislature for the legislative audit of the accounts and  
15 financial transactions of the government of Guam for the fiscal  
16 year ending June 30, 1971.

17 Section 4. The appropriation made by Section 3 of this  
18 Act shall be available July 1, 1971.

19 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any avail-  
20 able funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
21 sum of One Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$145,000) to  
22 the Legislature for the legislative audit of the accounts and  
23 financial transactions of the government of Guam for the  
24 fiscal year ending June 30, 1972.

1           Section 6. The appropriation made by Section 5 of this  
2 Act shall be available July 1, 1972.

3           Section 7. The Executive Branch of the government of Guam  
4 shall, upon receiving the auditor's report for the annual legis-  
5 lative audit, provide the Legislature with reports on its im-  
6 plementation of the recommendations suggested by the auditing  
7 firm, said reports to be submitted to the Legislature on a  
8 monthly basis until the recommendations of the auditing firm  
9 are fully implemented.
