

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 6 OF PUBLIC LAW
10-150 TO CLARIFY THE PROVISIONS RELATING
TO MONIES TO BE PAID TO ADMINISTRATIVE
OFFICERS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM WHO
ARE ENGAGED IN YEAR AROUND SERVICE.

1 WHEREAS, instructional personnel at the University of Guam
2 received an additional sum of 17% of their annual base pay for
3 the summer session period beginning 1970, such pay increase
4 being implemented by Executive Order; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tenth Guam Legislature seeing the inequities
6 which were created by said Executive Order adjusted the pay of
7 administrative officers of the University of Guam pursuant to
8 Public Law 10-150, Tenth Guam Legislature; and

9 WHEREAS, the Attorney General in interpreting the provisions
10 of Public Law 10-150, Tenth Guam Legislature interpreted certain
11 language within Section 6 of that Public Law to provide an in-
12 crease based on the administrative officers summer base pay,
13 rather than annual base pay as had been intended by the Tenth
14 Guam Legislature in enacting said Public Law; and

15 WHEREAS, while the Eleventh Guam Legislature is willing to
16 amend Section 6 of Public Law 10-150 in accordance with the

1 intention of the Tenth Guam Legislature in enacting said law, it
2 is nevertheless of the consensus that the Governor and the Civil
3 Service Commission should take appropriate action which is
4 necessary to remedy the problem for the future; now therefore

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

6 Section 1. Section 6 of Public Law 10-150 is hereby amended
7 to read as follows:

8 "Section 6. Effective with the commencement of the
9 1970 summer session of the University of Guam, adminis-
10 trative officers of the University who are excluded from
11 the benefits of the academic year employment system for
12 instructional faculty members shall receive, during each
13 summer session period, an additional salary sum equivalent
14 to 25 percent of their annual base pay, and shall be
15 entitled to eight (8) hours leave with pay for each
16 bi-weekly pay period, during each summer session."

17 Section 2. This Act shall expire at the end of the summer
18 session of the academic year 1970-1971.
