

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 8803 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO THE EMPLOYMENT, EDUCA-
TION AND TRAINING OF PRISON INMATES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 8803 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 8803. Labor, education and training of
5 inmates. The Director of Corrections is authorized to
6 permit a prison inmate to work at paid employment or to
7 participate in education or training programs outside
8 the institution if the Director, in his judgment, feels
9 that the employment or participation in the education
10 or training program will contribute to the treatment
11 and rehabilitation of the inmate. This authority shall
12 be exercised under the following criteria and conditions:

13 (a) Only inmates who have demonstrated good
14 behavior and some promise of being able to rehabilitate
15 themselves by engaging in gainful employment shall be
16 allowed to work under this provision;

17 (b) The working hours of such inmates shall be
18 determined by the Director of Corrections and his
19 employer. No inmate shall be permitted to begin work

1 prior to 6:00 A.M. nor be allowed to work past 7:00
2 P.M.; provided, however, that those inmates permitted
3 to participate in training or educational programs
4 shall be permitted to participate during such hours
5 as the Director shall determine;

6 (c) The inmates are to be restricted to the
7 premises of their employer during working hours;

8 (d) The wages to be paid said inmates shall be
9 the same as those paid to others for similar work in
10 the territory."
