AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1972; TO REPEAL PUBLIC LAW 11-25, ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE; TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE JUDICIAL BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1972; TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE GUAM LEGISLATURE FOR CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1971, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11 Section 2. The appropriation made by Public Law 11-25,  
12 Eleventh Guam Legislature, to the Department of Education and the  
13 University of Guam for fiscal year ending June 30, 1972, is  
14 hereby repealed in its entirety.

15 Section 3. All expenditures and encumbrances incurred by  
16 said Public Law 11-25, Eleventh Guam Legislature, is charged  
17 against the appropriation made by Section 1, Item VIII, of this  
18 Act.

19 Section 4. The Governor is authorized to transfer within  
20 departments from any allotment number not in excess of five  
21 percentum.

22 Section 5. For purposes of appropriations made herein by  
23 Section 1., VIII., B., 5., a., b., c., and hereafter enacted for  
24 all government of Guam scholarship and loan programs, no person  
25 who has not been a U. S. citizen and a bona fide resident of Guam  
26 for at least five years prior to the first day of September of  
27 the academic year for which he/she is applying for loan or scholar-  
28 ship shall be eligible for said loan or scholarship. Persons  
29 recruited from off-island for employment by the government of  
30 Guam, the Federal government, or any of their instrumentalities  
31 and agencies, or by private enterprises or private individuals

1 under a contract to fill positions in the territory for which no  
2 qualified local residents are available, and the dependents of  
3 such persons, shall not be eligible for grants and/or loans  
4 under the government of Guam scholarship and loan programs until  
5 they have completed at least five years of bona fide residence  
6 in Guam from the date of the termination of their employment  
7 contracts. To be eligible for scholarship awards, valedictorian  
8 and salutatorians and other graduating high school students  
9 shall have been bona fide residents of Guam for five years as  
10 prescribed in this Section above, and shall have taken all their  
11 high school education in Guam.

12 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
13 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
14 following sums for the operation of the Judicial Branch for  
15 fiscal year ending June 30, 1972:
